<u>Special Course Requirements:</u> - Required Professional Courses: 12 credits. - Starting from the second semester of their first year, students may take elective courses from master's programs of other departments or universities. The limit is one course per semester, up to a maximum total of 7 credits, which may be counted toward graduation credits upon completion. The "one course per semester" restriction does not apply to semesters spent on outbound exchange programs. Credits earned from inter-university courses must be approved by the department to be counted toward graduation credits. - All regulations regarding course enrollment and study shall be handled in accordance with the department's "Regulations for Master's Students."
